Keynote Address Two Centuries of Riding the Rails Presented by Patrick C. Morrison Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania

Mr. Morrison's presentation is "Two Centuries of Riding the Rails," which is a nostalgic look at rail travel over nearly two hundred years. The program starts by talking a look at how people traveled from Philadelphia to Pittsburgh in 1800, the 1830s, and the 1870s and beyond and how different travel was in those three time periods. The last part of the program takes our guests through a brief history of rail travel in this part of the country from the "golden age" of rail travel at the dawn of the 20th century through today.

BYLAW 12 -- NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

SECTION 6. A ballot suitable for publishing in the April issue of the Chapter publication bearing the names of all nominees, positioning of which shall be determined by lot, shall be prepared by the Secretary, along with voting instructions, how and by when to return the ballot to the Secretary and including a means of validating eligible votes. Ballots shall be due April 30th, validated and turned over to the Tellers Committee in sufficient time to permit counting prior to the May meeting of the Chapter
