Section 4.5. Continuing Professional Competency Requirements

(c) Each licensee shall be required to obtain **twenty-four PDH units** during the biennial renewal period. If a licensee exceeds the requirement in any renewal period, **a maximum of twelve PDH units may be carried forward** into the subsequent renewal period.

It is said that given a lemon, an Engineer will make lemonade. And our Chapter, Regional, State and National Societies have certainly made improvements as a result of the pandemic. Forced to use tools such as Zoom and Meet, we morphed from live to virtual meeting for education and camaraderie, then back. But we retained the use of virtual meetings for our Board meetings to conduct Chapter (or State) business. **We may again have live events** but now the ability to share with additional remote members and to record for future education are standard.

Our BootCamp is but one example of this hybrid delivery of knowledge. Budget has constrained us to but one center for LIVE classes, with the remainder of PA Professional Engineers served by Zoom. Perhaps **BootCamp25** will be provided live one day in Philly, State College, and Pittsburgh. After all, most need only 8 and not full 24 hours to top off.

And Zoom even allows us to invite lecturers to the LIVE event who are beyond travel limitations. Truly the hybrid of F2F and Virtual provides a better solution than last in 2019.

But it is important to continue work to provide F2F interaction and live networking opportunities. Our **BootCamp** will offer an option to attendees to meet socially after classes on Monday, and all Members of our Chapter and Region will be invited to join us. Our first Chapter Meeting SEP 7th will be a tour piggybacking to the [NavyYard Festival](#). Bring the kids!
