Our **BootCamp** will offer an option to attendees to meet socially after classes on Monday, and all Members of our Chapter and Region will be invited to join us. Engineer, Land Surveyor and Geologist Registration Law (Continuing Education Provisions)

Section 4.5. Continuing Professional Competency Requirements (c) Each licensee shall be required to obtain twenty-four PDH units during the biennial renewal period. If a licensee exceeds the requirement in any renewal period, a maximum of twelve PDH units may be carried forward into the subsequent renewal period.
