Topic: INCORPORATING WILDLIFE CROSSINGS AT BRIDGES AND CULVERTS

This presentation focuses on the habitat fragmentation criteria of the Flood Hazard Area Control Act rules. It will discuss the regulated streams and flood events in New Jersey. It will also provide the specific criteria of the fragmentation regulations, how it impacts NJDOT bridge and culvert projects, and the challenges on complying with the criteria. It will provide a case study on a project that faced significant challenges to the inclusion of habitat and how it was resolved.
