Electrical Safety in the Workplace

The National Electrical Code contains provisions that are considered necessary for Safety and has been adopted by most jurisdictions in the USA. Since 2002, the NEC has included a provision that equipment in commercial and industrial facilities be labeled to warn qualified persons of potential arc flash hazards. This course will review NFPA 70E, Standard on Electrical Safety in the Workplace and IEEE 1584, Guide for Performing Arc Flash Calculations that are used to evaluate when there is a potential arc flash and the danger that they impose in the workplace.
